WORKSHOPS "ON THE HILL" AT SING SING

After encountering administrative problems for a number of years, we have, at last, scheduled an AVP workshop "on the Hill" at Sing Sing. As you may know, the workshops that we have been regularly conducting at Sing Sing have been held in the Tappan section. This is the medium security division located on the shores of the Hudson. These workshops have been arranged through and supported by Tony Clark, administrator of the Network program. The inmate population of the Tappan section is less than 500.

The maximum security section of Sing Sing is located on the hill and has an inmate population of over 2,000. There is a great need for AVP here. To meet this need, Tony Clark has received the approval of the administration to hold workshops in the maximum security section and has arranged for space. A small group room can be used in the Substance Abuse Counseling Center. However, because of the size of the room, the number of participants must be limited to 12 with two or three facilitators.

The first workshop is scheduled for October 17-19 and we would like to have two outside facilitators and one inside facilitator. Please call Fred Feucht if you would like to lead the first workshop "on the Hill" at Sing Sing.

AVP PROGRAM IN

WESTCHESTER CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM
At the June Area Council Meeting, the program at both the Penetentiary for Men and the Women's Correctional Unit was reviewed. We have been holding regular workshops in both units for more than two years and there has been some concern about the low completion rate, especially in the men's unit. The completion rate is shown in the chart below. The area council is also finding it difficult to support the program at Sing Sing and other state facilities where the completion rate is high.
